**White Knight Viognier** 2018 Napa \$9.99  
*“Saving the world from the tyranny of chardonnay”*

Light straw in color with apricot and jasmine aromatics, this Viognier sings of summertime heat and ripeness. This blend is medium in weight with bright acidity to keep the finish refreshing.

**A to Z Chardonnay** 2018 Oregon \$14.99  
*“Brings out the best in food, friends, and Fridays.”*

Unoaked. **Wine Spectator Top 100 of 2019, Rank: #58:** Vibrant, with plush fruit, offering medium-weight lemon and quince flavors that take on expression and polish on the finish.

### **Colomé Estate Malbec** 2017 Argentina

\$23.99  
(\$19.99 w/B's card)

Bright, dark medium ruby. Lively aromas and flavors of crushed blackberry, licorice, bitter chocolate and mocha. As rich, concentrated and deep as this wine is, it's not over the top. This outstanding Malbec finishes ripely tannic and long, with compelling sweetness of fruit. (14.9% alcohol; this wine represents a blend of vineyards and altitudes in Calchaqui Valley; aged for 15 months in a mix of one- to ten-year-old French barriques) Vinous- 92 pts

### **Tessellae Old Vines** 2017 Cotes du Roussillon, France

\$13.99  
(\$11.99 w/B's card)

The 2017 Tessellae Old Vines checks in as 50% Grenache, 40% Syrah, and 10% Mourvèdre brought up mostly in concrete. Blackberries, kirsch, spice, incense, dried flowers, and baking spice notes all flow to a full-bodied, gorgeously texture effort. It's another gem from this team. Jeb Dunnuck- 92 pts

### **Casas del Bosque Gran Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon** 2017 Chile

\$16.99

On the nose elevated notes of blackberry, dark chocolate and mint. In the mouth, fresh acidity gives way to opulent notes of espresso bean, cedar and blackcurrant.
