Blackwater High Roller Sauvignon Blanc 2019 **€12.99**

Mineral-driven, featuring a silky texture and herbal core. Good acidity and balance with spice accents on the finish.

Boekenhoutskloof The Wolftrap Red 2018 **€7.99**

Syrah Mouvèdre Viognier has notes of black spice, dusty red plum and blackberry fruits with a soft smoky floral essence.

Featured

Mulderbosch Chenin Blanc 2018 **€13.99**

Fresh and simple with faint bitterness adding texture and complexity to the mid-palate. Fresh pears and apricots finish.

Goats do Roam White 2019 **€11.99**

39% Roussanne 38% Vignier 13% Grenache Blanc. Layers of lemon, peach and floral notes. Stone fruit and citrus flavors.

David Finlayson Chardonnay 2018 **€16.99**

Notes of cardamom and hints of salted butter that accentuate the pear and lemon flavors. Crunchy texture and spice details.

Black Pearl Oro 2018 **€16.99**

50% Cabernet Sauvignon 50% Shiraz. Aromatic strawberry, redcurrant, and sage bouquet. Medium-bodied, firm tannins.

Rust en Vrede Cabernet Sauvignon 2017 **€24.99**

Aromas of mocha, cocoa, blackberry, cassis and dried currant along with subtle oak tones. Full-bodied with a long finish.

Mulderbosch Faithful Hound 2015 **€19.99**

Ripe, earthy, blackberry and briar bouquet with hints of powdery dark chocolate and damp clay. Medium-bodied with grainy tannin.
