These wines were produced by vintners in what is called new world because they are produced all over the globe and not just France, Italy, etc. These are the same grapes that we know but are grown in many different terroirs. They were produced in New Zealand, Australia, California, Oregon, Washington, Argentina, etc.

One of the surprises was the Chardonnay from Wines of Substance. It was very fruity almost sweet but not quite. One of the comments was that it was completely opposite of the Chardonnay that we know. The Cabernet was also very fruity and not as heavy as I normally like it. However, I did like this one. It was also from Wines of Substance. Both were produced in Columbia Valley, Washington.

The wines we all rated at 88 and up and all were \$25.00 or less.
